"My heart is like wax; it is melted in the midst of my bowels."-Psalm 22:14

2 Samuel 17:10 Even he who is valiant, whose heart is as the heart of a lion, will utterly melt; for all Israel knows that your father is a mighty man, and those who are with him are valiant men.

Deuteronomy 20:8 The officers shall speak further to the people, and they shall say, "What man is there who is fearful and fainthearted? Let him go and return to his house, lest his brother's heart melt as his heart."

Ezekiel 21:7 It shall be, when they tell you, Why do you sigh? that you shall say, Because of the news, for it comes; and every heart shall melt, and all hands shall be feeble, and every spirit shall faint, and all knees shall be weak as water: behold, it comes, and it shall be done, says the Lord the LORD.

Joshua 2:11 As soon as we had heard it, our hearts melted, neither did there remain any more spirit in any man, because of you: for the LORD your God, he is God in heaven above, and on earth beneath.

Psalms 107:26 They mount up to the sky; they go down again to the depths. Their soul melts away because of trouble.

Psalms 112:10 The wicked will see it, and be grieved. He shall gnash with his teeth, and melt away. The desire of the wicked will perish.

- Live at PEACE don't be contentious, argumentative, hobby horses, disrespectful
- Admonish unruly Encourage fearful, Help sick, be patient,
- No repaying grudges –Pursue good –

- Rejoice always Pray always –
- Give thanks in every situation for this is GODS WILL FOR YOU
- Do NOT extinguish THE SPIRIT
- o DO NOT TREAT PROPHESY with contempt, but TEST the spirit
- Hold Fast to what is GOOD
- ABSTAIN from EVERY form of EVIL

The antidote -

1. HIS WORD and WAYS are SURE.

- 1 John 5:14 "Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us."
- a. Learn what God's will is, so we can ask properly?
- b. Studying His Word is a panacea to FEAR
- c. The Bible contains thousands of promises that clearly tell us how our Father wants to bless us, provide for us, comfort us, heal us, take care of us, and —draw us closer to Jesus.
- d. God only gives good and perfect gifts (James 1:17).
- e. He won't withhold any good thing from those who walk uprightly (Psa 84:11).
- f. Losing heart is A CHOICE
- g. ALIGN your prayers to God's Word.
